DUAL CREDIT COURSE UPDATES

Classes have started for both Olds College and Lethbridge Polytechnic!

If students are having difficulties, they are strongly encouraged to speak to their principal as soon as possible. Our school division will be required to pay the full cost of tuition for all classes when students withdraw from a course beyond the February 21st drop deadline at Lethbridge Polytechnic. Despite this fact, it is in a student's best interest to take a withdrawal (“W”) as opposed to a failing mark (“F”) on a post secondary transcript. The new list of Dual Credit courses will be available in May, with a semester 1 (Fall 2025) registration deadline of June 15, 2025.
